CASUALTY AFFAIRS SUPPORT SERVICES

Services Available for ALL Armed Forces 'Retired' Personnel

Assistance with:

- Retired Pay issues (remarriage, births, divorce, SBP premiums)
- Obtaining a DD214, NGB-22, or retirement order
- Claims and benefits to family members of deceased retired military
- Reporting of non-military spouse's death to stop SBP premiums or report to DFAS Retired Pay and the VA
- Assistance to survivors with VA claims and benefits
- Assistance with Estate Planning, getting things in order prior to death

Services Available for USAF Personnel only

Servicemembers Group Life Insurance (SGLI/FSGLI/TSGLI)

- POC for SOES/Milconnect and SGLI/FSGLI/TSGLI questions.
- SGLI/FSGLI/TSGLI can be viewed at www.va.gov
- SGLI ranges from \$4.50 to \$29.00 for coverage in increments of \$50K
- FSGLI is not always automatic rates available on www.va.gov
- TSGLI is an accident from an external force that causes a traumatic injury such as loss of hearing, sight, limb(s), and affects 2 or more daily living activities such as dressing, eating, or going to the bathroom. Members must contact their First Sergeant/Commander if hospitalized and provide medical records of treatment for traumatic injury. To qualify members must pay and have SGLI coverage.
- ACCELERATED BENEFITS OPTION allows a member participating in SGLI to apply for up to 50% of coverage if diagnosed with a terminal illness with 9 months or less to live. Remaining coverage balance will go to beneficiary.
- SGLI SDVI Service Disabled Insurance to qualify you must be retiring with a disability rating of 100% from the VA. This allows a member 2 additional years of SGLI coverage.

Survivor Benefit Plan (SBP)

MANDATORY SBP briefings for all USAF Active Duty AGR pay eligible upon retirement, PDRL/TDRL Medical Retirees, and those on Title 32 orders retiting, spouse too.

Reserve Component SBP No mandatory briefing required. Can help USAFR military members only with Retired Pay applications. Must know the RCSBP option chosen at 20-year point, must have VA disability paperwork in hand (efft date & amount), and if marital status has changed, it must be updated in DEERS and paperwork must be in hand when assistance is provided.

Services for Active Duty, Guard/Reserve on Drill status, ADT/IDT, Title 10 or Title 32 orders

Record of Emergency Data (vRED) - Keep it updated at all times

- NOT your source document for life insurance.
- Benefits listed on form include Unpaid Pay & Allowances and Death Gratuity.
- Changes to phone numbers, family members and addresses should be updated immediately.
- Unpaid Pay includes all accrued leave, pay, and bonuses payable to beneficiary (if applicable)
- Death Gratuity \$100K NOT payable to minor children without a court appointed guardian of child & property




